Feeling shame, girls often stay home from school during their periods, impacting learning and social development. Women may miss work, often losing wages and further compounding the cycle of poverty. Menstruators who live in situations of transience, transition or intimate violence frequently experience increased vulnerability during their monthly periods.

Dignity Grows Addresses Unmet Needs

Government benefits do not cover menstrual hygiene necessities, which are taxed in many states. Period products are rarely donated to food pantries. Each Dignity Grows Tote contains a month supply of sanitary pads and pantyliners, toothpaste and a toothbrush, a bar of soap, deodorant, shampoo and handwipes, all packed in a discreet, reusable zipper-top bag. Dignity Grows Totes are distributed through partner non-profit agencies that identify the need among their unique populations.

Since its founding in 2019, Dignity Grows has distributed 1.5 million hygiene products and launched chapters in dozens of communities across the U.S. Each Dignity Grows Tote is made possible through donated time and funds, uniting volunteers of all genders and generations to support our neighbors in need.
